

GOOD NEIGHBOR COMMITTEE

PURPOSE:

To provide food for community members in times of illness or bereavement.

GOALS:

- For a two-week period, provide food for the family of a community member returning home after hospitalization.
- Help families by providing food after a funeral or memorial service.

MEMBERSHIP:

Chair is appointed by the Board. Community residents participate in this service and provide meals and refreshments when requested to do so.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The chair establishes a schedule and, at the same time, notifies participants of any dietary restrictions.
- The resident providing food contacts the family involved to determine the time for food delivery.
- The chair will provide quarterly and annual reports to the Board.

MEETINGS:

This type of service does not require that meetings be held.

BUDGET:

There is no budget appropriation needed. The cost of food and communications is borne by the residents who participate.
