

**DEERLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION
RULES & REGULATIONS — PART 5 — POOL RULES**

GENERAL RULES

All pool users (residents and their guests) are required to sign in at each pool visit. The Sign In desk is located on the wall outside the lower clubhouse door.

1. There are no lifeguards. All pool users do so at their own risk and are advised never to swim alone. Safety is our #1 concern.
2. Residents should use their own pool key to enter the pool, and should not ask others to open the gate for them. Residents should not lend their keys to local guests (see Pool Use by Guests). If you lose your key and want a replacement, the fee will be \$15.
3. At the pool, residents are encouraged to display their Deerlake I.D. badge in a prominent and visible way.
4. Opening and closing dates for the pool will depend upon weather. Regular pool hours are from dawn until dusk. The Pool season typically runs from Memorial Day weekend to a few weeks after Labor Day, weather permitting.
5. Showers are available in the lower level of the clubhouse. A cleansing shower before entering the pool is required by law.
6. Anyone with a communicable disease, skin, eye, ear or nasal infections, or open sores is prohibited from using the pool.
7. Spitting, spouting of water, or blowing of the nose in the pool is prohibited. No diapers are permitted in the pool.
8. **Not permitted:** boisterous play, running, pushing, diving, or projectile-like water entries.
9. Animals of any kind are not permitted inside the pool enclosure.
10. No glass containers are permitted inside the pool enclosure.
11. Only proper swimming suits are permitted. Cut-off trousers are not proper swim suits.
12. No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the pool/pool area unless accompanied by an adult.
13. Rafts, inner tubes, and floats (except lifesaving or training devices) are not permitted when the pool is crowded - please be considerate of others.
14. Harmful objects (i.e. rocks, dirt, furniture, cans, etc.) will not be thrown into the pool.

15. Playing of loud music is prohibited.
16. All pool users must remove their trash on leaving the pool.
17. Smoking including e-cigarettes or other tobacco use is not allowed inside the pool enclosure.
18. The pool is **not** available for private parties.
19. Please place a towel on the chairs when using suntan lotion. After sun bathing, please shower before entering the pool.
20. When leaving the pool area, please:
 - Return chairs to their original places & positions.
 - Take your refuse with you.
 - Turn off all lights in the lower level of the clubhouse.
 - Be sure no faucets or showers are left running.
 - Close table umbrellas.
 - Be sure the door to the lower level of clubhouse is locked and the key is returned to its proper place.
21. Reminder: Please do **not** go through the clubhouse to enter or leave the pool area.
22. Emergency procedures are posted by the clubhouse door. The phone is for 911 calls only.
23. There will be **Adult Swim** from **4-6PM daily**, for adults (18yrs.+).

POOL USE BY GUESTS

1. Out of town house houseguests staying with residents have the same pool privileges as residents. Residents are responsible for making sure their house guests are informed of and abide by all the pool rules.
2. Local (day) guests who wish to use the pool must be accompanied by the resident and signed in. Households may not have more than a total of six local guest(s) visits per month.
3. Persons under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent, or a parent-designated adult.

THE POOL AREA, DUE TO ITS POPULARITY AND USE BY ALL AGES, IS OF CONCERN TO ALL. INFRACTIONS OF THESE RULES MAY LEAD TO LOSS OF POOL KEY AND POOL PRIVILEGES FOR THE SEASON.

These Rules & Regulations supersede all other such Rules & Regulations governing use of the Pool. These **Pool Rules**, which are **Rules and Regulations Part 5** of the DVCA, have been adopted and approved by the Board of Directors on the 16th day of April 2017.
