

DEERLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION RESIDENT IDENTIFICATION POLICY

In the interest of improved community safety and security for the Pool, the Lake, the Conservation Easement, and the clubhouse parking lot, the following rules will be observed and enforced.

Upon request, each **lot owner** will be issued a simple colored token with a printed number and the Deerlake Village logo.

- The tokens will be numbered consecutively with no duplicate numbers.
- No more than two tokens will be issued to each lot owner.
- Replacement tokens with a new number may be purchased at a cost of \$5.
- Tokens are not transferable and misuse of tokens to circumvent the intent of DVCA Rules and Regulations will result in a significant fine or the denial of the right to use the amenities.
- The Identification System will be implemented at the beginning of 2014.
- New tokens of a different color and shape may be ordered and distributed anytime at the Board's discretion.

Residents are expected to display their DVCA ID token when using the Pool, Lake, or Conservation Easement. The token may also be placed on the dashboard of a vehicle if that vehicle is being left overnight in the parking lot below the clubhouse. (see Parking Policy) Bearers of tokens may still be asked to identify themselves and provide their Deerlake address while using DVCA common elements.

Normally one token will be distributed to each lot owner. **Owners** may request up to two tokens. Homeowners with more than one property would not receive additional tokens unless a property is a house or condo that is occupied by renters.

Owners will be given the opportunity to pick up and sign for their token(s) four times a year: at the end of the Annual Meeting and at each Quarterly Meeting. **Condo owners** will be invited by their Association Presidents to pick up tokens immediately after each Quarterly Meeting of the DVCA. Upon written request, one token will be mailed to an out of town **owner** or **owner** unable to attend a specified meeting.

Upon sale of a property, owners should return their token(s) to a member of the Board.

The DVCA Board of Directors approved this policy on the 8th of October 2013.
